The rate of inflation continues to skyrocket and prices as well. We experienced this one day while waiting in line to get gasoline. The price literally changed just as we drove up to pump. In order for us to get to a rural area about 12 hours drive from Harare, we had to bring our own gas in the vehicle with us. The reason for bringing our own gasoline was to ensure that we would be able to make it there and back.

This remote rural area was called Binga. Someone told us that Binga was next door to hell, and after being there I realized why. It was so hot that jars of Vaseline melted and could be poured out like water. About one thousand people from Lubu in the Binga area walked to the ministry site where we set-up to minister, give clothing, and food. It was such a blessing to serve people who were in such dire need. We also distributed Bibles, books and personal items.



In a town called Domboshawa, we began the work of building Heart of Compassion Orphanage. We praise God for the land and a pastor who is a builder. He will be doing the work along with some hired laborers. Pastors Martin and Ivy Bernard of "Thy Kingdom Come" ministries will oversee all of the work on the orphanage in our absence. These are wonderful people we have known for several years, who have a heart for the needs of the people. We will be working with them on many joint endeavors.
